We support the allocations being made by policy C1(A), in particular site reference BOT5 Land at Normanton Lane, Bottesford.

Notwithstanding the calculation in paragraphs 4.2.18 – 4.2.22 and Table 7 of how the housing requirement should be apportioned, we so (A) being based upon the actual capacity of the deliverable sites which have been identified in each settlement. Any other approach ridelivery for individual sites, and would fail to accord with the Framework's core planning principle of encouraging the effective use of lar to accommodate development (paragraph 58).

In this regard, we note that policy C1(A) allocates only 405 dwellings, against a settlement requirement of 427. In particular respect allocation has not taken account of the site's topography and specific characteristics. A development on a larger gross site area will enawith a lower proportion of net developable area facilitating the incorporation of extensive landscaping and a layout which will be moving and a layout which will be movider landscape. The modest increase in numbers which this would facilitate would also assist in addressing the deficit currently preserved.

In this regard, initial survey and assessment work is currently being undertaken in preparation for an outline planning application to be date has confirmed that there are no technical constraints which would prevent delivery of housing on the site, and that the landscape most appropriate form of development for the site, which could accommodate approximately 90 dwellings. In addition, discussions are at the level crossing to the west of the site, and ensure that full consideration is given to all issues related to highways, access and transp

The boundary for allocation ref BOT5 at Normanton Lane, Bottesford should be extended to match that shown on the plan enclosed wit increased to at least 90. This boundary has been devised following a detailed assessment of the site and its surroundings, and are demonstrating the way in which a landscape-led approach can create a very high quality development in this location.
