Question11

Is the proposed designation as Local Green Space of land at Mill Lane Fields and also Dawson's Field¹, justified having regard to the criteria in Paragraph 77 of the National Planning Policy Framework and the advice set out in the Planning Practice Guidance?

Answer11

The NP Appendix C (Environmental Inventor) sets out the methodology and selection criteria (based on the eligibility criteria mentioned in NPPF para 77) which was used to identify and evaluate the four LGSs proposed in the Plan.

Mill Lane Fields (The Horse Meadow) (016) and Dawson's Field (01) scored 27 and 26 out of 32 respectively under these criteria (as evaluated by the advisory committee appointed by the PC and subsequently supported by local residents in consultations). They were the highest scoring sites of all 195 inventoried parcels of open land in the parish except for the already statutorily-protected churchyard and SSSI (sites 067, 068). The SHLAAs for both of the above sites have been rejected by MBC.
